Match Card Errors	<p>Issues causing problems</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blue/Black pen must be used – no red pen. • Reserves must be shown on the Match Card in the place indicated (different side to last year) • Mark borrowed players on the card. (Also please text Kala know about borrowed players, yellow card and red cards). • Only surnames and rego numbers to be written down – no initials, even if there are two players with the same last name. • Use this years ID numbers, not last year's numbers • Remember to sign the Match Card before the game (U6-U9) or after the game (10s and over). If there is an issue with score try to fix it then and there, If it cannot be fixed then contact Susan by email. Still sign the Match Card. • Sign on the line, not underneath it.
18.	ID Cards	<p>Being phased in is the need for the Manager for each team to check the ID Card, the photo and the shirt number against the Match Card.</p> <p>The plan is for each field to have an Officials table beside it, with the Manager from each team citing these details for the opposition players. The Match Card would be left at this table, which would cater for late arrivals. If the names are not checked off then the player is unable to play.</p> <p><u>This weekend</u></p> <p>There will be tables on the grounds, not necessarily one per field for these cards to be checked. Coaches/Managers can organise the check as best works for the team. Suggestion is the to the ID to the player who would front to the table for checking, and then hand the ID card back to the coach or another allocated person..</p> <p>This will be done for ALL teams – mini, junior and seniors.</p>
